TIPS

- Papers are intended for use to transfer to white and light colored materials consisting of 100% cotton, cotton/poly blends, or 100% polyester.
- When transferring onto 100% cotton, be sure the garment is "Pre-Shrunk".
- Choose garment that have a tight weave. This is particularly important when transferring onto sweatshirts. Best washability is achieved when using a tight weave, 50/50 fabric.
- Heat presses vary in accuracy, conduct your own tests to determine the best time and temperature to use with your own equipment.
- Best results are achieved with an Air Powered Heat Press.
- **IMPORTANT:** We thoroughly test each of our products on various substrates using different transfer equipment. However, it is impossible for us to duplicate all variables using all substrates and transfer equipment. Therefore, it is essential that you test the paper prior to production using your equipment, methods, and substrate material. Heat presses vary in accuracy. Conduct tests to determine the best time and temperature to use with your equipment. Please keep in mind that the Seller's and Manufacturer's maximum obligation shall be to replace any paper that has proven to be defective. Neither the Seller nor the Manufacturer shall be liable for any injury, direct or consequential, arising out of the use of, or inability to use this paper.

Photo-Trans® PLUS Fabric Laser Transfer Paper

Trouble free processing AND cassette feeding in most Color Laser Copiers/Printers.

IMPORTANT:

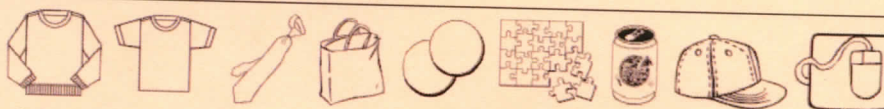
- **For color laser copiers/printers WITH FUSER OIL. DO NOT RUN THROUGH OIL-FREE FUSER MACHINES. Not recommended for HP printers.**
- For best results, transfer your image at the CORRECT TIME, TEMPERATURE AND PRESSURE.
- Store your Photo-Trans® PLUS Transfer Paper in a color, dry area and do not remove from carton until you are ready to use. After opening store the paper in a re-sealable polybag.

PRINTING:

- When holding Photo-Trans® PLUS paper, you will notice that there is no printing on the back. In order to identify the "print side", hold the paper so that the notched corner is in the upper right, the side facing you is the "print side".
- Select "Mirror Image" feature to assure image copies in reverse.
- **Photo-Trans® PLUS paper should be fed into your copier/printer with the short (grain long) dimension first.**
- Feed the Photo-Trans® PLUS paper according to the copier/printer manufacturer's directions. If you have any questions about how to feed the paper into the copier/printer brand and model you are using, please contact your manufacturer or dealer.
- Trim away any unprinted paper around your image that you do not want to transfer



PRESSING INSTRUCTIONS:



- It is recommended that you only use a commercial heat press when transferring with this paper.
- Pre-heat your heat press to 191°C/375°F and allow to come to set point.
- Set press for heavy pressure (60 psi or greater).
- Pre-press garment for a few seconds to remove moisture or wrinkles.
- Place transfer face down on garment and press for 25 seconds.
- Peel the backing paper off while still hot in a smooth even motion.
- For best 'hand', stretch the garment while hot.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS:

- Turn garment inside out. This will minimize the amount of abrasion that the transfer will encounter with other garments in the wash.
- Wash garment in cold water using mild detergent.
- **DO NOT USE BLEACH.**
- Remove garment for the washing machine immediately and allow to air dry. If you are using a dryer, tumble dry using air only setting. Using these recommendations will ensure that the image stays clear and bright.
- Do not iron directly on the transferred area..

NOTE: To bring brightness of colors back after washing, place a sheet of regular white paper over the image and iron at low cotton setting.
